She recently led the world's first randomized controlled trial studying the effects of diet on the symptoms of generalized anxiety disorder. Monique is an instructor at CCNM and the University of Guelph, a board member of INCAM research network and an editorial board member for the Canadian Association of Naturopathic Doctors Journal. She practices at Beechwood Chiropractic and Wellness Center in Norval.
